Constitutional	N/F/V/C/Weakness/Fatigue	Vasc: •Observation (eg, swelling, varicosities) and palpation (eg, pulses, CFT, temperature, edema, calf pain)
Eyes	Diplopia/Glaucoma/Cataracts/Spots	
ENT	Tinnitus/Vertigo/Sinusitis/Dentition	Neuro/Psy: •DTR, •orientation to PPT, •mood/affect, •protect/vibratory sensations
CV	SOB/CP/Murmurs/Fainting	•Coordination (eg, finger/nose, heel/ knee/shin, rapid alternating movements in the upper and lower extremities, evaluation of fine motor coordination in young children)
Respiratory	Wheezing/Hemoptysis/Cough/Pleurisy	
GI	Reflux/Diarrhea/Constipation/Hemorrhoids	
GU	Hematuria/Nocturia/Polyuria/Dysuria	Derm: •inspect/palpate skin(ex. Scars/lesions/rashes/ulcers/dyscoloration) on each UE, •inspect/palpate skin(ex. Scars/lesions/rashes/ulcers/dyscoloration) on each LE
Musculoskeletal	Pain/Edema/Erythema/Stiffness	
Integumentary	Lesions/Rashes/Lumps/Bumps	
Neuro	Weakness/Paralysis/Numbness/Tingling	Ortho: •alignment/symmetry/crepitus/defects/masses/tenderness each extremity, •ROM +/- pain each extremity, •dislocation/subluxation/laxity each extremity, • muscle strength and tone each extremity, • gait and station
Psych	Hallucinations/Voices/Suicidal thoughts	
Endocrine	Hypo/Hyperthyroid/Temp Imbalance	
Hematologic	Anemia/Bruising/Bleeding	Constitutional: •any 3 vitals, •general appearance
Allergic/Immunologi	Wheezing/Hives/Itching/Runny Nose	Lymph: •lymph nodes (neck/axilla/groin)
